 - Add two new pamphlets:

 - Remove the Guide to World Service which is not carried by the Service Center
 - Remove the Laminated Readings because the Service Center doesn't carry them. We will still have the regular non-laminated readings.
 - Remove the following items because we never stock them. If a group wants them, they can go to the Service Center or orders from NAWS instead of us holding their money for a month while we have to special order them and they may be out of stock or forgotten to be ordered:

 - Change the name of "Special Order Items" to "Service and Group Items"
 - Update the order form to list that we have medallion years 1 – 50. The form currently says 1-30 and we stock beyond 30 years. The Service Center order form says up to 50.
